The Mission of the Island Museum of Art (IMA) is to inspire and support artistic expression and education for the enjoyment and experience of islanders and visitors.

IMA provides changing exhibitions of local and regional artists of two-dimensional and three-dimensional contemporary and twentieth century art. Occasionally exhibits will include: special installations, nationally or internationally significant art, art of and for young people, and art on loan from patrons and other Museums.

IMA is a facility of the Westcott Bay Institute, a non-profit educational organization. Its facilities also include the Westcott Bay Sculpture Park, the Spring Street Landing Marine Aquarium Exhibits and the Museum Gift Shop. With the exception of certain works of art sold through the Museum Gift Shop, the works on display at the Park and the Museum are not for sale by the Westcott Bay Institute.
